Innovation

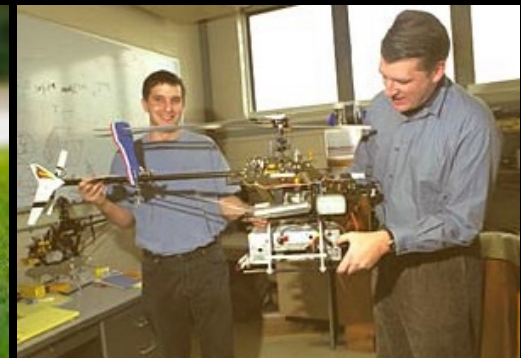
[in-uh-vey-shuhn]
